RED MESA ENHANCES ITS OIL AND NATURAL GAS OPERATIONS IN LA PLATA COUNTY

Company Announces New Field Headquarters and Field Infrastructure Improvements

DENVER, Sept. 23, 2008 – Red Mesa Energy Co. (“Red Mesa”), a Colorado-based oil and natural gas operator with producing wells in La Plata County, Colo., announced its new field headquarters located in Marvel, Colo., as well as substantial improvements made to wells and operating infrastructure.

Just four months after acquiring control of a 4,000-acre oil and natural gas field in southwestern Colo., Red Mesa has opened a new 1,500-square foot field headquarters conveniently located near the company’s more than 40 producing wells. The field headquarters increases the efficiency of operations as well as demonstrates the company’s long term commitment to growing and improving its operations in La Plata County.

Committed to increasing the production of oil and natural gas from existing wells, Red Mesa has reworked a total of 21 wells to date; immediately increasing production volumes. The company also completed improvements to its 6-mile long natural gas pipeline and more enhancements are scheduled to be made in the near future.

“Red Mesa’s immediate goal is to enhance and increase its production of oil and natural gas in southwestern Colo.,” said Rich Larson, Red Mesa’s vice president, energy asset management, who manages the company’s field operations. “Improving the company’s infrastructure, safety protocols and environmental protection practices aligns Red Mesa with its long term expansion plans in the region.”
